RE: Cease and Desist - Harassment and Interference with Employment

Dear Ms. Jackson,

I am writing to formally demand that you immediately **cease and desist from contacting**, **communicating with**, **or otherwise interfering with my past**, **current or prospective employers**, **colleagues**, **friends**, **acquaintances**, **or any other person known to me**.

Your repeated actions in providing negative information to my employers and prospective employers, colleagues, etc. are causing me significant economic and reputational harm. While you may claim that some of the information you are sharing is accurate, your deliberate and repeated conduct constitutes harassment and interference with my economic relations, which are legally actionable under Ontario law.

Take notice I am pursuing all legal remedies available to me, which may include:

- Filing a civil claim against you for harassment and economic damages;
- Seeking a restraining order or peace bond through the courts;
- Reporting your conduct to the police and filing charges as potential criminal harassment under section 264 of the Criminal Code of Canada;
- Filing a claim seeking compensation with Human Rights Tribunal of Ontario;
- Filing a claim seeking a punishable resolution with the Employment Standards Act of Ontario;
- Any other entity that may seem fit and appropriate to deal with this matter.

This letter serves as written notice that I am proceeding with all of the above. I expect written confirmation within **2 days** of receiving this letter that you are in receipt of this

notice, and will cease and desist from this harmful behavior effective immediately. Failure to comply has left me with no option but to escalate this matter through all available legal channels.

I trust you understand the seriousness of this situation, and you can expect to hear from my lawyer shortly regarding tort of interference with economic relations and harassment, among other things.
